As a constituent in your local riding, I am writing to ask that you actively advocate to have the Alberta Referendum Act amended.

The Citizens Initiative Act states that signatures from 20% of eligible voters (which according to 2020 stats from Elections Alberta – there were 2,824,309 eligible voters) which equates to 565,000 signatures would need to be collected within a period of 90 days. That's very unrealistic.

A referendum on Sovereignty should be held with 10,000 signatures.

There is no issue more important to Albertans than deciding whether or not, we are going to Free ourselves from the Colonial Powers in Ottawa that are continuing to try and destroy our lives, freedom and prosperity.

As a member of Parliament representing Albertans in your area, it should be vitally important that there be a (realistic) mechanism through which our views on this important issue be counted.
