Under Alberta's Citizens Initiative Act and Canada's Clarity Act, a successful referendum starts with action by informed citizens.

- 1** Collect Digital Pledge support Alberta Sovereignty
- 2** Register the petition with Elections Alberta
- 3** Collect Signatures from the public within 120 days
- 4** The Gov of AB accepts the petition; call a referendum
- 5** Referendum WIN with clear majority; Gov's to enter negotiations

Independence is on the minds of Albertans today.

Many Canadians (*even fellow Albertans*) say, "If you don't like Canada, move to the U.S." They argue, "If you don't like your neighbourhood, you move—not everyone else." At first, that sounds reasonable. But this thinking raises two moral issues.

First, it asks Albertans to walk away from the natural wealth beneath their feet (oil, gas, coal, minerals) and from the vast agricultural resources this province is known for. Nearly every Alberta job is connected to these land-based resources. They're the backbone of our economy and key to building a future for Albertans, their families, and generations to come. Telling people who reject federal policies like "leave it in the ground" or "eat bugs" to move away is not only unfair; it's morally wrong.

Second, we're not asking anyone to move. We're simply saying we no longer excessive regulation on how we live. We want the freedom to work, plant, and raise our future with less federal overreach. Sovereignty.

Why?

Because Albertans, as a people, have the right to self-determination—and that starts with the land they live on.

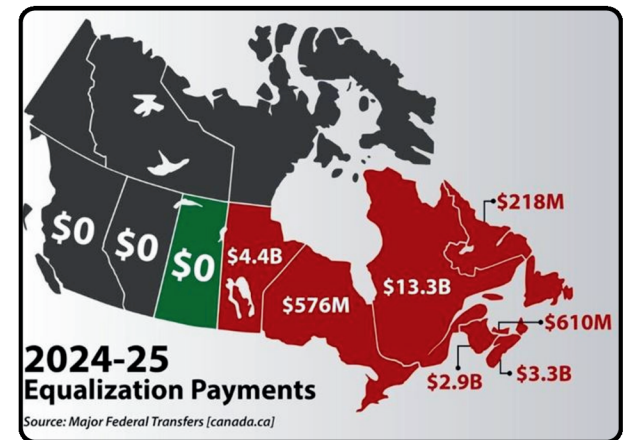

THE CASE FOR CHANGE

- Alberta has been treated as a resource colony by Ottawa since 1905.
- Our wealth fuels Canada, while Ottawa undermines our industries, prosperity, and self-determination.

HISTORICAL INJUSTICES

- 1904: Clifford Sifton planned Alberta as a subservient colony.
- 1980 NEP: Marc Lalonde admitted it was designed to stop Alberta from becoming an economic power.
- Today: The imbalance continues—and worsens.



DID YOU KNOW?

- Albertans pay \$60B in federal taxes annually. We get only \$27B back.
- We overpay into CPP (\$3B/year) & EI (\$1B/year).
- Since 1965, we've contributed \$700B through equalization & NEP—with no return.

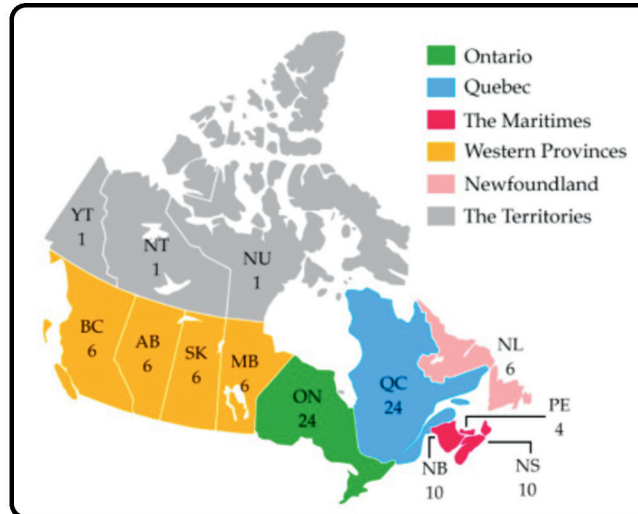
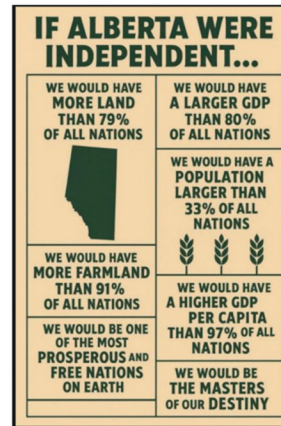
- Bill C-69: Blocks pipelines

THE PATH TO PROSPERITY (THE CONSTITUTIONAL WALL)

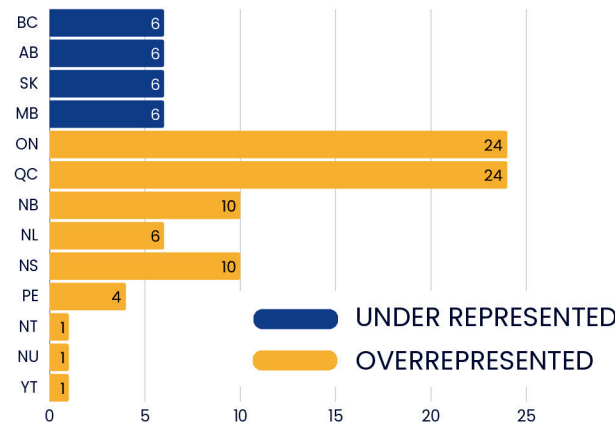
- Reforming the Constitution requires:

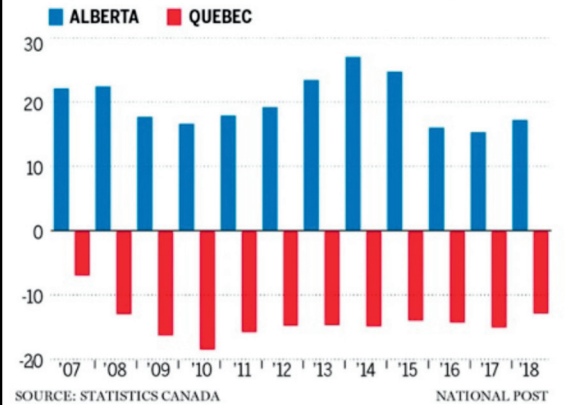


PROVINCIAL SENATE SEATS 2025



A FISCAL TALE OF TWO PROVINCES

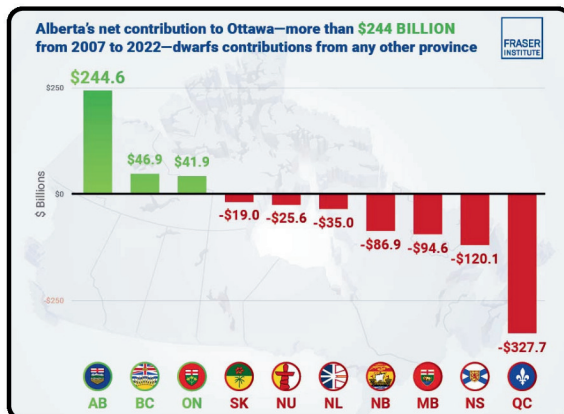
This charts show how from 2007-2018 Alberta was a big positive net contributor to the federal finances — it paid more in taxes than it received in federal programs and transfers. Quebec, over the same period, was the reverse, being a big negative net contributor (in billions of dollars).
